### **Hearts out – being Eucharist**

With the lockdown extended, how are you feeling? Hearts out to those without work and to government and community leaders trying to put support strategies in place. Hearts out to parents doing home schooling and to Year 12 students hoping this phase of their learning can bear the fruit of their goals. Hearts out to remote parts of the world unreported in the media where there is havoc and loss but little medical support or contact tracing available. Hearts out to single people living alone, to people who normally depend on family or a visitor to help with some basic tasks, and to people who are living in difficult relationships. Who are your 'hearts out' towards? Who can you contact by phone or online to be a 'presence' of connection, belonging and listening. When you think about it, that's 'being Eucharist' for others. Have a look in the parish website at that section called 'Life Bits' and you'll see a reflection on 'Being Eucharist'.

### Formative faith opportunities

Of course, we can't physically be together in the church at the moment. But imagine if someone asked us in a few months time; 'how did you grow during lockdown?'
